The Canadian Coast Guard Environmental Response Unit responded to a call of a vessel washed ashore in the Saanich Inlet area. The vessel posed an environmental hazard and was immediately extracted from the water to mitigate the threat to the surrounding habitat. Crew members on scene inspected the “Lady Patricia”, a 1975 24 foot Fiberform cruiser, and believe it was scuttled.
