On August 22nd the West Vancouver Police Department advised the Vancouver Police Marine Unit of the theft of an aluminum skiff from Horseshoe Bay that had occurred overnight between August 19th and August 20th. As a result of this information sharing, the VPD Marine Unit was able to recover the stolen skiff hours later at the municipal wharf in Snug Cove, Bowen Island. It is believed the suspect(s) used the vessel to transport stolen property from vessel break and enters in Horseshoe Bay to Bowen Island. When you fly a UAV or drone near or over a **#BCwildfire**, you're breaking the law and endangering firefighting personnel.

The restricted airspace includes a radius of five nautical miles around the fire and to an altitude of 3,000 feet above ground level. Transport Canada and the BC Wildfire Service explicitly prohibit the use of UAVs or drones of any size near a wildfire.
